

Call for Applications: MSA Trust Small Research Grant

The MSA Trust is now accepting applications for Small Research Grants. We aim to advance understanding of Multiple System Atrophy (MSA) by supporting innovative research projects that contribute to improving clinical care and management for people living with MSA.

We welcome proposals for clinical care research that demonstrate originality and relevance. Collaborative projects, within the UK are encouraged.

Note that proof of concept projects will be considered, however if you are a current grant recipient, the project cannot be an addition to your main grant research.

Funding Available: Up to £10,000 per project

Project Duration: Single or multi-year proposals are eligible

All applications will be reviewed confidentially by our Scientific Advisory Panel (SAP), chaired by Dr. Christopher Kobylecki of Salford Royal Hospital. If additional expertise is required, the Chair may refer applications to an external peer reviewer.

Applications can be submitted at any time but will only be reviewed by SAP quarterly
